PMI STUDENT MEMBERSHIP - USD \$32

Available for students enrolled full-time in a degree granting program at a college or university that has U.S. accreditation or global equivalent.

GROUP STUDENT MEMBERSHIP

This program allows universities to purchase student memberships for a roster of students enrolled in a credit-bearing course. The cost is \$32 per student, regardless of enrolment status (full or part-time student). CAPM CERTIFICATION

The CAPM is an entry-level certification ideal for university students. The CAPM exam is a 150 multiple-choice question exam based on the PMBOK[®] Guide. To be eligible to take the CAPM an individual must have 23 classroom hours of project management education and a semester-long project management course would fulfill this requirement.
