








Program and Timeline

PMI Sweden Mentoring program

- For members
- 6 months duration
- Minimum 4 mentor meetings
- PDU (6 Mentee /12 Mentor)
- Webpage filled with valuable materials

2020: 5 mentor/ mentee relations


2021: 9 mentor/ mentee relations

2022: Goal to have 20 mentor/ mentee relations

Important Dates (preliminary):

26 Oct - Introduction & initiation

9 Nov - Matching should be finished and Mentoring begins

1 Feb - Halftime follow up

3 May - Final follow up & End of program


Requirements:



What is mentoring?

"A powerful personal development and empowerment tool.

A helpful relationship based on mutual trust and respect."

PMI Mentoring Handbook

The goal of the mentorship program is to contribute to professional development and provide the conditions to create a stronger network between the members of the organization.

"Mentoring is to support and encourage people to manage their own learning in order that they may maximise their potential, develop their skills, improve their performance and become the person they want to be."

"This Mentoring scheme expects The Mentor to be more experienced than the Mentee to pass on specific advice and examples from their own experience. The Mentor will help the Mentee improve their professional skills in the project, program and portfolio management disciplines, according to their needs stated on application

PMI Mentoring Handbook



The Mentor's role is to:

...provide support and guidance to Mentees, providing the Mentee with development opportunities based on agreed objectives.

- Should be a program or project manager or similar, with management experience to share.
- Must be a current member of the PMI Sweden Chapter
- Should be a successful professional with the right attitude, willing to share knowledge with the Mentees.
- Please note that this is a volunteering role, without remuneration other than the ability to claim PDUs.



The Mentee's role is to:

that the scheme is used as an opportunity for personal development, based on agreed objectives.

The most suitable Mentor required to achieve that goal is not necessarily someone more senior.

- Mentees have the duty to specify their expectations, needs and goals they want to achieve during the mentoring program.
- This will facilitate the mentors' role and will contribute to a successful mentor-mentee relationship



Mentor or Coach?

Mentor - The Definition

A mentor is someone who shares their knowledge, skills and/or experience, to help another to develop and grow.

Coach - The Definition

A coach is someone who provides guidance to a client on their goals and helps them reach their full potential.





Mentorship is ... "a helpful relationship based upon mutual **trust and respect**."


Code of Conduct



PMI-SE Web App Updates

Summary

- Updated functionality and design of the profile page
- Adding links to the individual's profile for LinkedIn, Facebook and Web page
- Choose the role(s) of interest (Mentor, Mentee or both)
- Search for other individuals that have signed up for the same mentor program, based on role (mentor/mentee), interests, competences, name
- Button to initiate a Message in My Contact and in the My Contacts list
- Option to change/update the contact relation
- Signing up for a program (like "PMI-SE Mentor program 2022")




The PMI SE Web App – Logging in

Start by logging in to pmi-se.org
To log in click on "Mina sidor"

Enter your email address or PMI membership ID and password and click "Logga in"

When you have successfully logged in, you will see the shortcut menu at the bottom of the screen. Use this menu to navigate to the different functions described in this quick reference.





The PMI SE Web App – Updating your Profile

Start by updating you own profile


Start using the new functionality by updating your profile, adding contact information and selecting your preferences. Login is required.

Some basic information is inherited from pmi.org and cannot be changed. To updated that, you will need to do that in your profile on https://www.pmi.org/

Adding a photo will make your profile look better, more personal and make it easier to find you.

You may also choose what users will be able to see and connect to you.

Password may also be changed here.







The PMI SE Web App – Updating your Profile – New functionality

- Profile presentation
 - You can now provide a short presentation of your self
- Link to your LinkedIn profile
 - If you want to share your LinkedIn profile, please add your public profile URL
- Link to your Facebook profile
 - If you want to share your Facebook profile, please add your public profile URL
- Web site link
 - If you want to share your web page, please add your web site URL
- Are you looking for a mentor or adept (or both)
 - Select from dropdown list
- Select whom to share the information with










The PMI SE Web App – Updating your Profile – New functionality

The PMI SE Web App - Connections


Search and manage Connections

- Mentorship: Looking for a mentor or mentee/adept






The PMI SE Web App - Messaging


Send messages from the search page

The PMI SE Web App - Messages


Keep in touch with Messaging

You may send and receive messages with your contacts.

Messages is not an email function, but more similar to the messaging functionality on other social media platforms.

It works similar on all device platforms, except for the interface being slightly more limited on your smartphone.

When a message is sent, an email notification will also be sent to the email address of the recipient.







Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Who should initiate the contact?

A: Both the mentee or the mentor could do it.

Q: I have never been a Mentor, can I still be one.

A: Yes, as long as you have experience in a PM area and want to use that to help someone else grow.

Q: Can I be a Mentor as well as an Mentee?

A: Yes, one person might have a lot of experience in one area and at the same time have a need to have some guidance in another area.

Q: Do I need to find someone in the same kind of business as me?

A: No, we have heard from some Mentors that thought it was very rewarding to have someone in another line of business as it forced them to adjust their knowledge to suit the Mentee.

Q: What is the process of creating action plans for the mentee during/after meetings with the mentor?
